## Undeniable Signs of the Times are Before Us... (Wake Up) Please!

*"Therefore He says: Awake, you who sleep. Arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light" (Ephesians 5:14).*

The people of Noah's Day did not believe that Judgment from God would fall. They went about their lives as just another day. The signs were all around them but they fail to see. They don't listen to the Bible, go to church meetings, fellowship with other believers, but do get themselves into debt because of materialism that floats before their eyes, and their children are not in the house of God.

March winds are blowing. The angels are lining up for God's big call. The trumpet will sound, the dead in Christ will rise, and those left behind will have something else to deal with. Now is the time to prepare. Now is the time to read God's Word, shift from the moral fault of allowing the river of Salvation to pass by.
