Later, Lord!

Acts 24:24-25

KMBC Family,

Times are strangely different, eerie at least, and I believe we are exponentially, rapidly reaching the tipping point for the Revelation. I'm not talking about the Rapture, when God rescues His people from this world before the tribulation, but of the 2nd Coming. I pray that you are ready for that day!

Here's some notes from Sunday's Sermon.

Paul appears before the Governor of Judea. He is a cruel, compromising, corrupt man. By his side is his wife, Drusilla, who is a seductress and glad to leave her first husband for a wealthier man. Enters Paul through the doors, the gospel messenger, God's man for both of them and for us. Paul is in chains, while Felix isn't. Paul is free on the inside of his soul, while Felix is chained. Felix is Governor and Paul is the Gospel preacher. Paul is headed for glory and Felix and Drusilla is headed for destruction. If you were Paul what would you say? Paul reasoned with them of righteousness, self-control, and judgment to come.

1. Paul spoke to them of the Righteousness of God which they did not possess.

Righteousness cannot be earned. Righteousness of God goes beyond man's righteousness. God is thrice holy and if we are to know anything of eternal life, we have to realize we are lost and have not the righteousness of God. God loves the sinner, but He is also angry with the sinner. God hates the sin and so should we. Would anyone of you have a rattlesnake in your bed while you sleep? God gave us the Ten Commandments to show us that we do not have His righteousness. We are condemned!

2. Paul spoke to them of self-control which they did not practice.

Felix and Drusilla both were people out of control. Their lives were one of pride, presumption, and thumbing their noses at God. Both left their first marriages for the lust of each other and what they could get out of it He was powerful, and she was beautiful. Their lives were out of control. Murder, drink, sexual sin, adultery, parties, were all they were concerned about. He an older man, she a teen girl, but both were not in control. People call sin other names. Adultery is called an affair, lying is called a credibility gap, while thievery is called embezzlement. When Paul reasoned with them, he made the message relevant to their lives. That is what the gospel of Christ does. Only by the Fruit of the Spirit can a person be controlled by God and that only by His salvation.

3. Paul spoke to them of judgment to come which they were not prepared.

Many are not prepared today. There is a future judgment. If you ever have been in a courtroom you know the seriousness of the hour. As Paul spoke, he pointed out to them that there would be a different judge, a different courtroom, and a different day. God has appointed a day of judgment and He will judge the world by His Son (*Acts 17:31*). They couldn't face the music! They were enraged in the middle of Paul's sermon and by now Felix was shaking in fear. Friends, one day the Books will be opened, and the works of man will
