The Christmas Story

Since the fall of Adam, only one person has lived a normal life. There is no waking moment where a child of God has to live in and out of himself.

Herod said, "No!" The wise men said, "Yes!" Simeon said, "Yes!" Mary said, "Yes!" Joseph said, "Yes!" Satan said, "NO!" Unless one is born from above they will not or cannot enter into the kingdom of heaven. You have to say "Yes" to Him and that means to see yourself crucified with Him who died for you. You have to die with Him to have Him enter into you!

If you are born again, Praise God, Hell will not open its mouth for you! If you say "Yes" to Christ daily, then earth will not receive you! But when you say "Yes" to Christ, He will surprise you with what He will and can do on this earth! What a Savior!
