Years ago, I would take our newborn baby daughters, snuggle them inside of a soft throw, and hold them as they slept. Their hearts were beating, I felt and heard their breath, and their soundtrack was the beating of their father's heart.

Can we say, "God, let that be me. So close to you that I can hear Your heart. Hear my breath, my heart, let it beat for Thee."


