PAUL'S LIFE OF THANKSGIVING

If prayer is the source of spiritual power, then it is easy to understand how the apostle Paul was the strongest Christian in the history of God's church. At the beginning of Paul's conversion, we find him waiting for Ananias in the house of Judas. One could find Paul on the street called Straight. The Bible tells us that he was found praying (Acts 9:11). This was the picture and posture of a man that would show up during his whole career with Christ. This man prayed. It was his spiritual power.

Paul instructs each of us to pray without ceasing, to pray one for another, to pray with thanksgiving, to pray with the armor of God, to pray in the Spirit, to pray for those in authority, to pray for all things in all situations. Paul was a great instructor of prayer because he was a great intercessor of prayer.

E.M. Bounds said of Paul,

"If Paul was the first of the apostles, prayer conspire to that end. He made praying a habit, a business, and a life. Praying made up the substance, the bone, the marrow, and the very being of his religious life."

Paul's life was ceaseless, resolute, a voluntary outpouring of prayer to God. In Paul's final testimony, he declared, "For I am now ready to be offered and the time of my departure is at hand" (2 Timothy 4:6). When the entirety of one's life is given to prayer, he will see death as a final and rewarding answer to his lifelong request. He would see Christ the One to whom he was praying throughout the course of his ministry.

History knows of Paul's power because heaven knew of his petitions. Such is the power of prayer. Everything is done by it, and there is nothing without it.

May we work at prayer because prayer works.
