Why Do We Celebrate Easter?

Every day is a day to celebrate the finished work of Christ! We reflect upon His work each Easter Sunday and I'm glad. It was chosen before Adam was created to have the Second Person of the Godhead to bear our sins on the cross. It was chosen that Jesus would die in our place and that we would die in Him.

Most do not realize the powerful work of Christ on the cross. The self-life of each who comes to Him by faith is slain and crucified. The old person we were is now crucified allowing the God of glory to dwell and perform in us and through us to make Himself visible. We live by faith and not by sight.

What is God's good pleasure? It is He who is performing in us. He is working everything together for this one purpose: "That the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our mortal flesh" (2 Cor. 4:11). This is life: "For to me to live is Christ" (Phil. 1:21).




