## The Bible

Charles Spurgeon said, "A Bible that's falling apart usually belongs to someone who isn't."

Billy Graham has preached the gospel in person to more people than anyone in church history, reaching over, it's reported, 210 million people in 185 countries. Billy Graham in 1949 had a crisis of faith before his first crusade in Los Angeles — one that would reach 350,000 people, but there was a problem beforehand. He had a crisis of faith. He began questioning whether the Bible truly was the inspired Word of God.

You see if he could not trust the Bible, he said, "*I could not go on. It was not too late to become a dairy farmer.*" In the middle of the night, there in the San Bernardino Mountains, he fell on his knees and, laying the Bible on the ground, he cried out, "*Oh God, there are many problems I don't have the solution for!*" But at last, the Holy Spirit freed him to shout in those mountains, "*Father, I am going to accept this as Thy Word by faith. I'm going to allow faith to go beyond my intellectual questions and doubts, and I will believe this is Your inspired Word!*"

That night, God filled the greatest evangelist of our time with words that would ring across the world to millions of souls: "*The Bible says...*" and it became his most famous line every time he preached. The Bible was at center stage of the tent crusade having within a large replica of an open Bible — twenty feet high and twenty feet wide. Billy wanted the Bible behind him as he preached. And the power of God rested upon that meeting.

Today it seems as if people would rather have songs than sermons, play more than pray, and ball more than Bible. There is absolutely nothing wrong with worship songs, play and recreation, and sports and ballgames. The problem today is that we are losing another generation before us. What is incubating today will be the children of tomorrow. The problem is "*They do not know the Word of God*" because parents and grandparents do not disciple.

If the Word of God is **LIVING**, and **SHARP**, **THEN Don't Make It Dead, Dull, and Blunt**. Our happiness is connected to the Bible. Our children's and grandchildren's happiness are connected to the Bible. As our happiness increases it will be because our Bible habits increase. Read it, listen to the words, and obey what is written. God promises that His Word will never return void!
