September 17 – Say your first verse: Genesis 22:8a

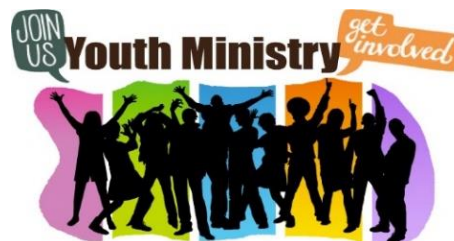
September 24 – Highlight Jesus / Highlight Others
