True ministry takes place on a battlefield. We are called to move forward despite our opposition that comes to us, even to our minds. Paul has given us the secret to overcoming our seemingly tough ordeals.

Paul said, *"I can do all things through Him who strengthens me"* (Philippians 4:13). Many people use this verse for many silly reasons. Yet primarily this verse has to deal with pain and difficulties. Paul said, *"I can overcome all things through Him who strengthens me."* He was in prison, my friend. Don't forget that.

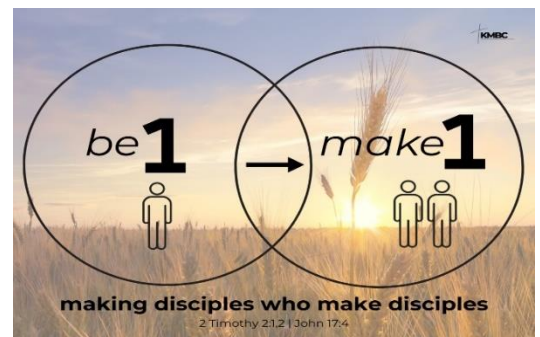
