You can worship God in Heaven. You can praise God in Heaven. You can sing songs to God in Heaven. You can learn God's Word in Heaven. But one thing you cannot do in Heaven is share your faith with a non-believer. Why? Because everyone in Heaven is a believer.

When we take our last breath, you will never be able to talk with a lost personal friend. It must grieve the heart of God to see so many who have no real concern for the lost and dying.

God burdens our hearts to reach the lost, but we must get out there and start practicing those conversations. There are only two times to share the Gospel with people: in season and out of season. Any other time would be wrong!

Isn't it amazing that the God who is in total control of this universe will take time out of His day to see us read His Word and to hear us pray to Him? Listen, we get to go to church. We get to read His Word. We get to pray! By the way, when we die, we GET to go to Heaven because He sought us out.

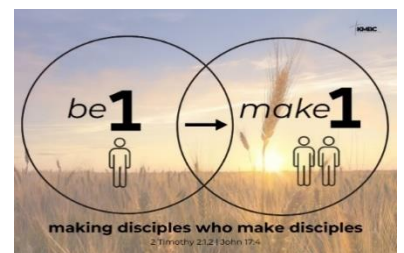
It was okay for Jesus to be a friend of the tax collectors, prostitutes, and sinners, but it is apparently not okay for us. Don't allow anyone to keep you from loving people with the gospel, not even religious people.

Again, Spurgeon said, "*I would sooner bring one sinner to Jesus Christ than unravel all the mysteries of the divine Word, for salvation is the one thing we are to live for.*" We need to ask the question "*Do we believe in Jesus as the Son of Man who came to save that which is lost?*" Did He not tell us to "*be fishers of men?*"

May God stir the church to be the few who will go and tell! This is what the church is about and what the church should be trained to do in D-groups, services, and Bible fellowships. There are many other multi-faceted things of the church but without a believing soul proclaiming the gospel the church will flounder.

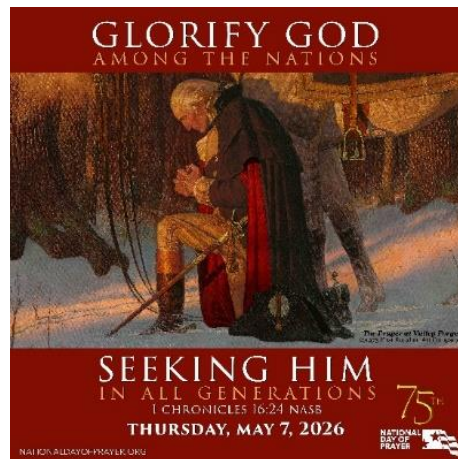
